AGREEMENT RESOLVING THESE
CONTESTED CASES
REVISED VERSION

Petitioner and Respondents (hereinafter, collectively referred to as "the parties") having negotiated through the efforts of their attorneys and Patricia Kotyk-Zalisko, Esquire, Settlement Officer for the Office of Administrative Law, and the parties

having successfully negotiated an acceptable settlement as a result of such efforts,

NOW THEREFORE, the parties in exchange of mutual promises hereby set forth the full terms and conditions of the settlement of this contested case on this 11th day of July, 2002 as follows:

(1) The three respondents: Mega Construction Corp., Joseph Pallonetti, individually, and Eugene Kaczmarek, individually, hereby accept debarments for a time period of three years each, commencing July 15, 2002, and concluding on July 14, 2005. All three names shall appear on the debarment list maintained by petitioner New Jersey Department of Labor for the time period indicated. Notwithstanding the foregoing or anything herein to the contrary, the parties agree that no provision of this Agreement or any act required by this Agreement will be construed as an admission of liability by or among Mega Construction Corp., Eugene Kaczmarek and/or Joseph Pallonetti.

(2) Collectively, a monetary penalty totaling ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$100,000.00) DOLLARS shall be paid by respondents to the "Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Labor" in twelve equal installments with firm due dates for said payments to be in

the Commissioner's hands reliably and on time as follows:

Said monetary penalties when received by the Commissioner shall be apportioned among the various monetary categories of "penalties, fees, and wages" in the Commissioner's sole discretion.

(3) No later than Monday, July 22, 2002, respondents shall surrender their original Contractor Registration Certificate No. 589063 held by Mega Construction Corp. by delivering said original document to:


(4) The rights of individual workers, if any, should any so choose, to proceed on their own with collection actions against respondents are not waived or impaired in any way by this agreement. Notwithstanding the following and/or anything herein to the contrary, it is agreed between the parties herein that the Agreement shall not be admissible in any proceeding before the Office of Administrative Law and/or the Superior Court of New Jersey, Law Division and/or Chancery Division, and/or any other court of the State of New Jersey, excepting therefrom that any party herein shall have the right, if applicable, to enforce the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and Petitioner may use this Agreement as evidence of a "previous violation" within the confines of N.J.A.C. 12:60-8.3(c) should any penalty cases involving Respondents arise after July 15, 2005.

(5) Subject to the terms of this Agreement, petitioner hereby withdraws its revocation, debarment, and collection actions against respondents encompassed by the above-captioned OAL docket numbers. Similarly, respondents withdraw their appeal encompassed by the same docket numbers. The aforesaid withdrawal by Petitioner of its Petition to revoke and/or debar and/or collect wages, penalties, interest, etc. shall be dismissed with prejudice and without cost to either side.


(6) The fulfillment of serving the penalty time represented by the debarment specified in paragraph (1) above, and/or the full and timely payment of the monetary penalty specified in paragraph (2) above shall not be used as grounds for denial of any future application by Mega Construction Corp. for renewed Contractor registration on or after July 15, 2005. It is however, understood and agreed that the Department of Labor reserves its right to review all such applications on their own merits, and to respond to them in accordance with the Department's general responsibilities under law.

The Parties warrant and certify that their duly authorized representatives, with authority to accept the terms and conditions of this agreement on behalf of the petitioner and



Dear Mr. Ganopoulos:

At the outset let me express my appreciation for your having taken the time to hand write your concerns and provide the undersigned and my client the opportunity to respond thereto. In this regard we are mindful of the desire on behalf of everyone to conclude this matter once and for all. Indeed, it has been and will continue to be the position of Mega Construction(MEGA) that it will do all that is necessary to comply with the reasonable requests of the Department of Labor.

Having said the above, I will address each of the concerns that you have listed on your hand written letter of (14) pages. However, as a preliminary matter it must be emphasized (i) that a number of the workers you have identified are supervisors whose job responsibilities include and are not limited to supervising a number of projects in different locations at the same time which are within their area of expertise, i.e. layout etc., and (ii) are therefore, on occasion, listed as having worked at a particular site, albeit erroneously, for the entire day which necessarily creates the impression that they are working more hours than actually worked when their name appears elsewhere for that same day. Workers who fall within this category are Sylvester Baptiste, Ray Muller, Michael Ahern, Oscar Aranguren, Claudio Galindo, Edgar Infante, Glen Slocum, and Christopher Mach. Accordingly when you picked up their names as having worked additional hours at other sites it became patently obvious that their hours were being recorded as full days for each of the projects that they were working on. By way of illustration, Ray Muller worked on several projects for the week of October 5, 1999 at the Arbor Glen which was both a prevailing wage rate and a non-prevailing wage

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rate job. For that week he received a gross of \$1000.00 and on the certified payroll he shows as having received \$952.56. According to the records you reviewed he also appears as having (16) hours at B-unit Conversion at Arbor Glen. Obviously, what occurred is that he was credited with more hours than he actually worked by the person in the field reporting the hours. The best proof of this is that Ahern has not complained to either the State and/or to the company that he was shortchanged for that week. Parenthetically, this was explained, in part, to you when you were at the offices of Mega on the last occasion in the presence of the undersigned and Angela Lindsey. Finally, it also must be emphasized that not one employee and/or supervisor has filed any complaint with the Department of Labor alleging that they were underpaid and/or not paid the correct amount of wages for any of the years in question!

Proceeding further with this response, the following are my comments. For the sake of convenience, I have responded page by page to yours. Also, I have taken the liberty of identifying those individuals who were supervisors and just noting that fact without elaborating and/or repeating the above explanation.

Page 1 of 14:

Sylvester Baptiste, Ray Muller and Michael Ahern all are supervisors. With respect to Ray Muller and Michael Ahern, there were three (3) Arbor Glen projects going on at the same time. The men were checked in at the other sites and were erroneously put on the time sheet as time for whole days.

Page 2 of 14:

The work sheet reviewed for Oscar Aranguren shows that he only worked eight (8) hours on Wednesday. Consequently, the total should be eight (8) hours for the week and not fifteen (15) hours. The fifteen (15) hour total is obviously incorrect. The same error occurred with respect to Claudio Galindo - his hours for the week (Wednesday) show four (4) hours. Consequently, the total for the week should be four (4) hours and not eleven (11) hours - eleven (11) hours is an obvious mistake. Edgar's time is correctly recorded as eight (8) hours for the day and week.

Peter K.: The time sheet for 430 East 80th Street review shows that for the week ending 11/9/99, he is listed as having worked a total of eight (8) hours, but there is no indication as to which day of the week. On the time sheet reviewed (week beginning 11/3/99), he is listed as having worked at Willow Creek on Wednesday for a total of eight (8) hours. Only one conclusion can be drawn and that is the eight (8) hours for 340 East 80th is incorrect.

Franciswzek M. is listed as having worked sixteen (16) hours at the Rug Mill. The records also show eight (8) hours at Willow Creek for a Tuesday night. The only conclusion to be drawn is that he probably worked for a different contractor that evening.

Page 3 of 14:

All supervisors.

Page 4 of 14:

All are supervisors

5 of 14:

All are supervisors.

6 of 14:

Oscar Aranguren and Claudio Galindo are supervisors.

As for Jan K., Robert M. and Stanley Stulak, their compensation based upon the total hours averages to between \$10.70 and \$11.46 per hour. However, it should be noted that Stanley Stulak is listed as having worked eight (8) hours on Thursday at Willow Creek and also eight (8) hours at the Courtyard, Marriott for the same day - an obvious error.

Jan W. is listed as having thirty-four (34) hours at Willow Creek. This is an error. The time listed is thirteen (13) hours. The number (34) was incorrectly copied.

Page 7 of 14:

Oscar Aranguren is a supervisor. As for Robert M. and Jan W., it should be noted that Jan W. only worked eight (8) hours at Shrewsbury on Wednesday, not the twenty-two (22) hours listed. The number was incorrectly copied. It appears the recorder took the number twenty-two (22) for the employee above, Jan W. Moreover, Robert M.'s pay averages for the work performed \$10.81 per hour.

Page 8 of 14:

Robert M. and Jan W. are a Megan Construction problem. As discussed previously, Megan hired our employees for a project Megan represented was not prevailing wage rate.

Page 9 of 14:

Robert M., Jan W. and Edward S. are again a Megan Construction problem - see explanation on Page 8.

As for Glenn Slocum, he is a supervisor, and it would physically be impossible for him to be at Shrewsbury and Towson, Maryland at the same time. Records are obviously incorrect.

Page 10 of 14:

Oscar, Claudio and Edgar are supervisors.

Page 11 of 14:

The time listed for Henryk G., Oto F., Franciszek M. and Jan K. are listed as having worked at the Rug Mill for a total of eight (8) hours for the week, yet no day of the week is marked for any hours. Hence, time improperly recorded as men did not work during the week on any designated day.

As for Milan K., he is listed as having worked eight (8) hours on Wednesday at the Rum Mill, but no total hours for the week are reflected - another error.

As for William O'Leary, this is not our employee. Our employee whose last name is O'Leary is identified as "Billy" on our time records and not as "William."

Page 12 of 14:

Christopher M. is a supervisor.

As far as Henryk G. and Milan K., the company is still researching its records.

As for Oto Falis, the weeks of August 15th and August 22nd, he is listed on several occasions as having worked eight (8) hours on the same day at two (2) different locations - an obvious error.

Page 13 of 14:

At the outset, William O'Leary is not our employee. (See above explanation).

As for "Israel" - from the time sheet, the reporter has concluded that this Israel is the same Israel who worked at Shrewsbury and Bridgewater. This conclusion is erroneous because the days in question are the same days for both projects.

Christopher Mach is a supervisor.

Eddie Stulak is listed as having worked at the Rug Mill and Bridgewater on the same days - an obvious error.


Oto Falis is listed as having worked at Bridgewater and Romero on the same days - again, an obvious error.

Finally, for the week ending September 19, 200, Stulak is listed as having worked thirty-two (32) hours at Romero when the record shows only sixteen (16) hours. Moreover, he is listed as having worked the same days at Bridgewater and Romero.

Page 14 of 14:

William O'Leary is not our employee. Again, O'Leary, our employee, is identified as "Billy "
